Baranduda Range

social ride

Visible from Wodonga the Baranduda Range is a major feature on a drive to Beechworth or Yachandanda. The plan is to start on the eastern side of the range at Mt Baranduda, skirt around the private property to the transmission towers and then follow the ridge trail west along the range. Great views of surrounding areas are abundant along the ridge. The ridge trail is completely fire road but there will be a bit of single trail whilst skirting the private land. Do not be deceived by this though, It's a great ride in the hills.

Schedule

Start 10am—Meet at the round about where the Beechworth/Wodonga Road meets Baranduda Blvd. This is located only a couple of Km's from the outskirts of Wodonga. From here we will organize car shuffles so we have some cars at the start and some at the finish.

Finish 1-2pm— Where the Ridge Line Track meets the Kiewa Valley Highway

Difficulty

Even though we are starting on top of a mountain the ride still has 2 long steepish climbs with a few little ones thrown in for good measure. Nothing that rivals Mt Stirling but significant all the same. There is a quite steep descent to finish off with so please ensure brakes are in good working order with plenty of wear left on the pads. Ride is open to everyone except complete beginners.

Compulsory Equipment for Ride

- A mountain bike in good working condition designed for off road use
- **A Spare Tube, Pump**
- Australian Standards approved helmet
- Appropriate footwear - No Sandals
- Enough food for ride - up to 3 hours
- At least 2 bidons of water (1.5litres if you have a camelback) If you do not have water, you will not ride!!!!
