Come and explore all that Bright has to offer in MTBing. The location of a 6 hour race in November very few have experienced what has previously been known as a great MTB mecca. *If the weather is rain or snow then this social ride will be cancelled.* This ride is free of charge if you don't have an MTBA licence then you are required to fill out a participation licence.

Groups and leaders

Jayne – beginner/intermediate group – Along the river to Wandiligong approx 2 hours return

Dan and Geoff S – Advanced group – An epic of great proportion approx 3 hours

Course description

Wandiligong river trail – relatively flat trail but fun and windy, mostly on well defined walking tracks with a number of cable bridge crossings, tree roots, small rocks and a couple of paddock crossings ending at the historic Chinese bridge just outside of Wandiligong. This is a reasonably technical ride.

Epic adventure – a mix of 4WD tracks, bitumen, single-track and walking trails, this ride will take you close to 1200m. With a gradual 1.5 hour climb and a 20 minute descent, the highlight will be the Clear Spot Lookout offering full views of Bright.

Start time

Both rides will start at 11am and all riders will meet at Mobil service station, Wodonga Place at 9.30am to organise car pooling. Car pooling is a lot more economical and there are a number of people willing to give others a lift. If you would prefer to drive straight to Bright let me know and we will organise a meeting point.

Ride time

Allow between 2 – 3 hours ride time. Please bring enough food and drink for this length of time.

Essential equipment

It is Winter and Bright is in the Alpine Region so **WEAR WARM CLOTHING**, thick gloves and socks are recommended along with a waterproof shell! All riders must have a MTB appropriate for off road riding with working brakes, an Australian standard helmet, spare tube, at least one drink bottle and a multitool with tyre levers. If you do not have appropriate bike and equipment then you may not be allowed to participate.
